California Wildlife Poster Contest

held in conjunction with the **19th Annual Audubon Wildlife Education Day**
Saturday October 23, 2010 at McClellan Ranch Park in Cupertino.

- **Grades:** Preschool through 12th grade
- **Theme:** **California Wildlife and Habitats** - Choose one category from the following list:
San Francisco Bay Parks Wetlands Forests Deserts
Creeks or Streams Pacific Ocean Wildlife Backyard Creatures
- **Slogan:** All posters **MUST** contain a slogan/message about native, California wildlife or habitat. *Examples:* "Cougars Need Space Too!" "Don't Pollute Our Wetlands!"
- **Medium:** Any medium acceptable - crayon, paint, pen, collage, paper, fabric, etc.
- **Size:** NO LARGER THAN 12 X 18 INCHES - please!
- **Entry Form:** Fill out the entry form located on the back of this flyer and place it on the back of the poster.
- **Posters will be judged by the following criteria:**
 - Only posters containing **CALIFORNIA WILDLIFE IN NATIVE HABITAT** will be accepted.
 - Submit only original artwork. No tracing or direct copies (the use of stickers is discouraged).
 - Posters should be fully detailed, and the full space should be colored or drawn.
 - **Posters must be turned in by Friday, October 8, 2010 to be considered**
- **Awards:** 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbons awarded for each grade level (Grades 9-12 will be grouped as one category). Art Studio participants will be judged in a separate category. Every participant will receive a Certificate of participation. **Winners announced at 1PM on Wildlife Education Day (October 23rd, 2010)!**
- **Winning posters will be displayed at the SCVAS office on Wildlife Education Day**, the SCVAS website, and may also be displayed after the event by one of our local sponsors.

ATTENTION TEACHERS! Please limit entries to the **top 6 posters** from each class - **DO NOT submit a poster for each (i.e. all 30) student!** – and submit by **Oct. 8, 2010**. A typed/printed list of names for the contest entries - with correct spelling - must be included with submitted posters. A free Bird Poster or Presentation will be available by request to teachers submitting 6 entries!
